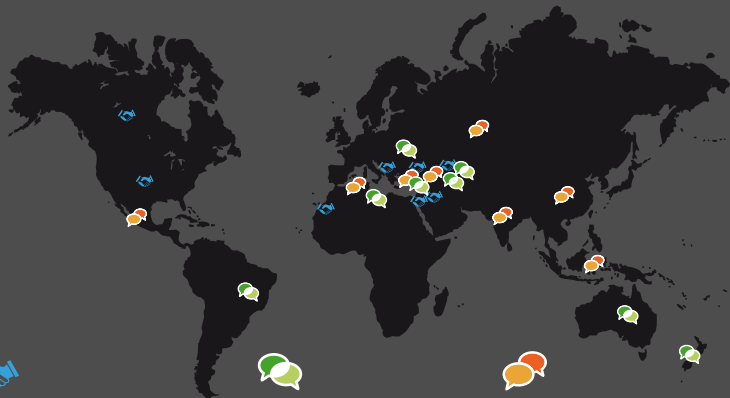




8 aviation agreements signed to better connect Europe to the outside world
