REPORT SUBMITTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 10(1) OF REGULATION (EU) 2017/1926

We are hereby submitting the report on the national access point and the modalities of its functioning required by Article 10(1) of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/1926¹.

By Order No 3-210-(E) of the Minister for Transport and Communications of the Republic of Lithuania of 21 May 2014 approving the procedure for the collection of public transport travel data² and Order No 3-609 of the Minister for Transport and Communications of the Republic of Lithuania of 17 September 2012 approving the provisions governing the public transport travel data information system (hereinafter 'the Provisions'), the Lithuanian Road Administration was tasked with collecting, organising, supplying and otherwise processing public transport travel data.

In accordance with this legislation and with Directive 2010/40/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 7 July 2010 on the framework for the deployment of Intelligent Transport Systems in the field of road transport and for interfaces with other modes of transport, on 15 July 2015 the Road Administration created the public transport travel data information system (Vintra) and is processing the data collected in that system.

The quantity of data stored and processed in the Vintra system and the criteria for publishing them and supplying them to third parties are consistent with the provisions of the Regulation.

Data are collected for all data providers according to equal and non-discriminatory conditions on the basis of a standardised data provision contract concluded with providers. Moreover, all of the data collected in the database are publically available via the website www.visimarsrutai.lt. Consumers can use this website not only to obtain public transport data but also to plan a multimodal journey.

In order to promote data availability for third parties (software developers), an open data web service has been created. Data can be accessed at http://www.visimarsrutai.lt/gtfs/. Use is free of charge, and no data-supply contract need be entered into.

The Vintra information system contains both static and dynamic public transport travel data of types corresponding to the data categories set out in the Annex to the Regulation (level of service 1). A detailed list of the data stored in the system is provided in the Provisions:
