# COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING DECISION

## **amending Implementing Decision C(2014) 1921 establishing a Multi-Annual Work Programme for financial assistance in the field of Connecting Europe Facility (CEF) - Transport sector for the period 2014-2020**

THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 July 2018 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union, amending Regulations (EU) No 1296/2013, (EU) No 1301/2013, (EU) No 1303/2013, (EU) No 1304/2013, (EU) No 1309/2013, (EU) No 1316/2013, (EU) No 223/2014, (EU) No 283/2014, and Decision No 541/2014/EU and repealing Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 110 thereof,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) No 1316/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 establishing the Connecting Europe Facility, amending Regulation (EU) No 913/2010 and repealing Regulations (EC) No 680/2007 and (EC) No 67/2010<sup>2</sup>, and in particular Article 17(1) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) On 26 March 2014 the Commission adopted Implementing Decision C(2014) 1921 establishing a Multi-Annual Work Programme 2014-2020 which provides support under the Connecting Europe Facility for projects of common interest in the transport sector in the form of grants and for programme support actions<sup>3</sup>.
- (2) In line with the evolving priorities in the implementation of the Trans-European Transport Network policy objectives set out in Regulation (EU) No 1315/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council<sup>4</sup>, it is necessary to update Implementing Decision C(2014) 1921 to ensure a smooth transition between the current programme and its successor programme, by providing support to studies in view of the preparation of projects for the next period.
- (3) An indicative maximum amount of EUR 200 million should be made available to support the objectives of this decision.
- (4) In order to ensure consolidation of all budgetary commitments of the Connecting Europe Facility – Transport sector from 2014 onwards, Annexes III and IV of Decision C(2014) 1921 should be replaced by updated Annexes.

- (5) Implementing Decision C(2014) 1921 should therefore be amended accordingly.
- (6) The measures provided for in this Decision are in accordance with the opinion of the CEF Coordination Committee established by Article 25 of Regulation (EU) No 1316/2013,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

*Sole Article*

Implementing Decision C(2014) 1921 is amended as follows:

- (1) Article 2 is replaced by the following:

*“Article 2*

*Union contribution*

The maximum Union contribution for the implementation of the programme for 2014 - 2020 is set at EUR 23 476 501 035 and shall be financed from the appropriations entered in the following lines of the general budget of the Union:

- (a) budget line 06020101: Removing bottlenecks, enhancing rail interoperability, bridging missing links and improving cross-border sections: EUR 8 538 320 270, out of which, for programme support actions: EUR 83 754 544;
- (b) budget line 06020102: Ensuring sustainable and efficient transport systems: EUR 916 334 147, out of which, for programme support actions: EUR 45 272 695;
- (c) budget line 06020103: Optimising the integration and interconnection of transport modes and enhancing interoperability: EUR 2 769 007 287, out of which, for Programme Support Actions: EUR 127,690,889, and for contribution to an entrusted body - the SESAR Joint Undertaking: EUR 10 000 000;
- (d) budget line 06020104: Connecting Europe Facility – Cohesion Fund allocation: EUR 11 252 839 331, out of which, for programme support actions: EUR 21 968 892.

The appropriations provided for in the first paragraph may also cover interest due for late payment.

The implementation of this Decision is subject to the availability of the appropriations provided for in the general budget of the Union for 2020 following the adoption of that budget by the budget authority”;

- (2) An Annex II *sexies* entitled ““CEF - Transport funding referring to objectives and priorities to be implemented by calls for proposals under the Multi-Annual Work Programme 2014-2020 in 2020”” set out in Part I of the Annex to this Decision is added to Implementing Decision C(2014)1921.
- (3) Annex III to Implementing Decision C(2014) 1921 is replaced by the text in Part II of the Annex to this Decision.

- (4) Annex IV to Implementing Decision C(2014) 1921 is replaced by the text in Part III of the Annex to this Decision.
