Digitalising freight transport across the European Union

The **eFTI Regulation** will unlock the potential of **electronic data exchanges** to replace paper-based systems and, in the process, it is set to transform the EU freight transport sector.






This **digital shift** will ease the administrative burden on businesses and authorities related to complying with EU and national freight regulations.

Authorities in all EU Member States will be required to accept **electronic data** when shared by businesses via eFTI certified platforms.

The eFTI standards will also facilitate information **sharing** between businesses, making logistics processes more efficient.







Operational framework

Cargo transport data will be shared via secure, **eFTI-certified IT platforms** that can be easily integrated with companies' existing data management systems.

The data will only be shared with authorities following a specific inspection request, using unique access links in machine-readable formats, such as QR codes.

The eFTI platforms will also allow companies to share data selectively with their business partners by granting them tailored access rights.

Key benefits









For Businesses

- Transport operators will have fewer unexpected stops and shorter delays caused by inspections.
- Instant sharing of data with partners through eFTI platforms will enable more efficient logistics planning, vehicle loading, and routing.
- Businesses will save up to EUR 13 per each consignment note. Annually, this could amount to EUR 1 billion in administrative cost savings for the EU transport and logistics sector.

For Authorities

- Simplified compliance checks will result in better targeted inspections and shorter inspection times.
 - Officers can view information in their own language, thanks to automatic translation of the data shared electronically by businesses.
- Information on checks performed electronically may be processed for monitoring and reporting purposes.

Towards a future-ready EU

The eFTI Regulation will promote innovation in freight transport and logistics, support more sustainable transport, and boost the global competitiveness of the EU transport and logistics sector.
