









COVID-19: effects on rail transport volumes












A congested network




THE RAIL SECTOR REMAINS a key employer in the EU economy

CONNECTING people and businesses

Total length of rail network: 200100 km

Around

81.6% of total train-kilometres are travelled by electricity-powered trains

High-speed network by the end of 2020 **11526 km** + 1464 km (+13%) compared to 2015 Average distance between stations in the EU27 (2020) 6.7 Km
