The transport sector is the backbone of the EU economy: it provides millions of jobs, connects businesses, and brings people together. However, urban transport is responsible for **23% of the EU's greenhouse gas emissions** and a cause for the increasingly severe air pollution in many urban areas. It is estimated **that air pollution is responsible for more than 430,000 premature deaths** in Europe. With this new set of legislative initiatives the Commission aims at increasing the share of low-and zero-emission vehicles powered by alternative fuels in the EU. This will improve the quality of life of citizens while keeping a highly competitive industry capable of generating sustainable growth.
