**Call for proposals with a view to obtaining grants in the field of road safety for  
the organisation of a youth forum for road safety**

Updated: 20/09/2012

- The call indicates that the estimated total amount for 2012 is €150 000. Does this "total amount" refer to the total amount provided by the Commission under this call, to the total eligible costs of each project, or to the amount of the EC co-financing for each project?

150.000€ is the maximum budget available for the co-financing of the selected project. Only one proposal will be selected.

- In accordance with point 4. of the Call, is it possible to receive funding for the action from non-EU body for up to 50% of the total costs?

Only legal entities established in an EU Member State are eligible. Entities from other countries can be part of a project but their cost will not be eligible.

- Are public or private universities eligible to participate under this call?

Public or private universities are eligible provided that they are established in an EU Member State.

- In accordance with points 9.1 and 9.2 of the Call, does the required 3 years of experience refer to the applicant organization(s)? If so, is it possible for the members of a consortium to meet that criterion together?

Please refer to the following paragraph of point 9.2 "Applicants should have 3 years of experience in the field of road safety for young people. They should also demonstrate their experience in the organisation of international conferences".

The criterion must be fulfilled by the consortium as a whole but at least one partner must have the requested 3 years of experience. In other words, we can accept that one member of your consortium has 3 years of experience in the field of road safety for young people and that another member can demonstrate its experience in the organisation of international conferences even if it has no special experience in road safety.

- How many projects are expected to be funded?

Only one project will be selected.
